Chen Clinical Research Fellowship for further research in deep immunophenotyping and genotyping of complex immunodysregulatory disorders. She was jointly awarded the NAM-HKU Fellow in Global Health Leadership (2020-2022) by the National Academy of Medicine (USA) and the University of Hong Kong.
